

DWD FREE PATTERN #1
Two-Tone Shrug for SD Sized Dolls (shown on Narae)
(Will fit other similar dolls, Volks SD 10, 13, Tonner' s American Model)

The book “Fitted Knits” by Stefanie Japel inspired this pattern. This simple shrug dresses up any girl’ s wardrobe. Perfect over sundresses or skirts and tank tops. Sure to keep the evening chill off her shoulders! Uses two colors for a complimentary and eye catching combination.

Rating: #1 – Easy – The pattern uses only knit and purl stitches and is knitted from top down. The neck, front and bottom ribbing is knit in the round.

Two-Tone Shrug for SD Sized Dolls

Yarn: Jamieson's Lace Weight Shetland Wool Yarn

Gauge: 11 sts per inch, 14 rows per inch with 0 (2 mm) size needles

KFB – Knit 1 front and back: Inc 1 st by knitting into the front and back of the next stitch

PFB – Purl 1 front and back: Inc 1 st by purling into the front and back of the next stitch.

pm – Place Marker

sl – Slip a marker from the left needle to the right needle, knitting the sts before and after it as usual.

With size 0 needle and **waste yarn**, cast on 27 sts. Do not join. Work 3 rows of stockinette stitch.

Row A (not counted, WS): With main color yarn, purl 5 sts, pm, purl 17 sts, pm, purl 5 sts.

Row 1: (RS): KFB, [knit to 1 st before marker, KFB, sl marker, KFB] twice, knit to end, KFB. 33 sts.

Row 2: P all sts

Rows 3 – 26: repeat rows 1 and 2.

Row 27: Repeat row 1 (111 sts) (RS)

NOTE: The sts in the section between the two markers is the lower back edge. The sts outside the markers are for the sleeves. Place the back and right sleeve on holders. Sleeves should have 33 sts each, back should have 45 sts.

Left Sleeve:

Row 28: P all sts (WS)

Start new row count

Row 1: KFB, knit to last st, KFB = 35 sts (RS)

Row 2: P all sts (WS)

Row 3: KFB, knit to last 2 sts, KFB twice (38 sts) (RS)

Row 4: P all sts (WS)

Continue to knit in stockinette stitch even for the next 20 rows. [Total of 24 rows.]

Change to CC and work k2, p2 rib (start and end with k2) for 16 rows. Cast off in pattern.

Right Sleeve: Replace right sleeve sts on needles and work as for left sleeve with the exception of Row 3

Row 3: KFB twice, knit to last st, KFB (38 sts) (RS)

Seam sleeves.

Ribbing: With RS facing and beg at back right shoulder, using 0 needles and CC, pick up 120 sts around the entire edge, including lower back edge from stitch holder. To be knit in the ROUND, with whatever method you prefer. I found it easier to use waste yarn on the neck edge. It makes a neater edge. Remove waste yarn once you have the stitches on the needle. You should have 15 sts from neck edge, 30 sts down left sleeve, 45 sts on back edge, and 30 sts on right sleeve. Evenly space the 30 sts on each sleeve. Work a K2, P2 rib for 8 rounds.

1st Inc Round: [K2, P2 - 93 times 12 sts], K2, PFB, PFB, [K2, P2 (2 times, 8 sts)], K2, PFB, PFB, [K2, P2, (19 times)] K2, PFB, PFB, [K2, P2, (3 times 12 sts)], K2, PFB, PFB

You should be back at the beg of next round.

Work one round in rib, keeping in pattern correct by working P4 in the increased sections.

Next row: Keep in pattern of the K2, P2 rib and in place of the P4 sts, work K2, P2 pattern.

Continue to work even, keeping in pattern for 8 more rows

2nd Inc Round: [K2, P2 (3 times 12 sts)], K2, *PFB, PFB*, K2, *PFB, PFB*, [K2, P2 (2 times, 8 sts)], K2, *PFB, PFB*, K2, *PFB, PFB*, [K2, P2, (19 times)], K2, *PFB, PFB*, K2, *PFB, PFB*, [K2, P2 (2 times, 8 sts)], K2, *PFB, PFB*, K2, *PFB, PFB*

You should be back at the beg of next round

Work one round in rib, keeping in pattern correct by working P4 in the increased sections.

Next row: Keep in pattern of the K2, P2 rib and in place of the P4 sts, work K2, P2 pattern.

Continue to work even, keeping in pattern for 8 more rows. Total of 168 sts.

Cast off all stitches in pattern.

Weave in ends and block if desired.
